
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






35 LANGUAGES = CONCRETE COLUMNS

12 LANGUAGES LEFT STANDING = 12 COLUMNS ON THE BUILDING






CONCEPT: THE INKANYAMBA

The 2024 PG Bison student competition invites students across South Africa to design an innovative, immersive destination hotel that provides quests with a luxurious 5-star international hotel experience—right within their own country. This challenge encourages students to create a space that combines world-class luxury with the rich diversity and distinctive character of South Africa, offering visitors a unique experience that celebrates local culture, landscape, and hospitality.

The Inkanyamba, a legendary serpent in Zulu mythology, is believed to reside in the deep depths of the Howick falls. This mythological creature symbolizes power, mystery, and the unbridled energy of nature. It is known to protect the falls and the surrounding land. Inspired by the Inkanyamba, my building design embodies fluidity and dynamic movement, with sweeping curves and flowing lines that mimic the serpent's form. The structure integrates natural elements like water features and green spaces, creating a harmonious blend with environment. This design not only pays homage to Zulu heritage but also emphasizes the strength and power inherent in natural phenomena. It aims not to disturb nature but to seamlessly blend into it.




CANDALLABRA BLU
